

SERVICE SUMMARY

Flu Immunisation Service

Cheshire East

Summary

The aim of the Community Pharmacy influenza vaccination programme is to protect those who are most at risk of serious illness or death should they develop influenza, by reducing the risk of transmission of infection from employees. This will be achieved by delivering an evidence-based influenza vaccination programme, specifically aimed at employees of the Council that are authorised to access the service.

How to

Deliver

The vaccination programme is specifically for employees of Cheshire East Council not eligible for flu vaccination via the national scheme. The service will operate through eligible staff accessing the service by way of presentation of their Cheshire East Council ID badge or school ID badge or official Cheshire East Council letter.

Steps

- Check eligibility for funded vaccine
- Clinical assessment for suitability
- Administer the vaccine
- Complete the consultation
- Record the administration

How to Qualify/DoC

- Ensure all staff are legally able to supply and/or administer the vaccine by working under the PGD
- Provide proof of professional indemnity insurance
- Have a standard operating procedure in place for the administration of influenza vaccination
- Complete the vaccination services Declaration of Competence (DoC)

How/When to Claim

The programme will operate from 1 October 2020 to 31 March 2021

The data management system (PharmOutcomes) will produce an invoice at the end of each month; therefore pharmacies will not need to invoice the Council. Providers must ensure that each Cheshire East Council identification number is recorded on PharmOutcomes.
