How to

Summary

Deliver

The pharmacist is to perform a consultation with the patient in private to assess the suitability of emergency contraception. as well as providing information about what to do in the long term, such as considering options for ongoing contraception available. Offer patient POP. The pharmacist should also advise on the risks of sexually transmitted infections (STIs). Offer chlamydia screening service to patient, the pharmacist may also provide additional advice on safe sex and other matters relating to sexual behaviour.

How to

Qualify/DoC
