Dear Colleagues,

The Pharmacy First service launched on 31 January 2024. This service is an expansion of the previous Community Pharmacist Consultation Service. Whilst still encouraging GP practices to refer appropriate patients with minor illness to be managed by community pharmacies, in addition seven new clinical pathways have been introduced. The new clinical pathways enable community pharmacies to treat suitable patients without the need for prescription from their GP.
