Free COVID-19 lateral flow tests available here

For those who have been deemed to be at a high risk of becoming seriously ill from COVID-19.

You or someone that you care about may be at the highest risk of becoming seriously ill from COVID-19 if you have/are:

- Down's syndrome or another genetic disorder known to affect the immune system
- Certain types of cancer, or have received certain types of cancer treatment (such as chemotherapy or radiotherapy)
- Certain conditions affecting the blood (including cancers that affect the blood and sickle cell disease)
- Are resident in a care home or already hospitalised and are aged 70 years and over, or have a BMI of 35 or more, diabetes or heart failure
- Certain kidney diseases
- Certain liver diseases
- Had an organ transplant
- Certain autoimmune or inflammatory conditions (such as rheumatoid arthritis or inflammatory bowel disease)
- Certain lung conditions
- Certain people with end stage heart failure who have a long-term ventricular assistance device
- HIV or AIDS and have a weakened immune system
- A condition affecting the immune system
- Certain conditions affecting the brain or nerves (such as multiple sclerosis, motor neurone disease, Huntington's disease, myasthenia gravis, Parkinson's disease or certain types of dementia)
- Aged 85 years and over
- On the organ transplant waiting list
