Healthy Living Pharmacy (HLP)	Contractual	31 March 2025	 Pharmacy owners must undertake at least one community engagement exercise per financial year on the promotion of healthy living which involves: Actively working in collaboration with other organisations to deliver pharmacy outreach and any locally commissioned services; and Taking prevention and health promotion services beyond the pharmacy premises. Pharmacy outreach may be face to face and take services to people where they live or spend time or may be virtual events 	
Advance Services Bundling	Service Income	31 March 2025	 From 31 March 2025, community pharmacies must deliver a bundle of services to qualify for the monthly £1,000 payment. This includes: Pharmacy Contraception Service Hypertension Case Finding Service Pharmacy First 	
NHS Pharmacy Profile Update	Contractual	31 March 2025	Ensure your Directory of Services and NHS website profiles are accurate by updating your <u>NHS Profile Manager</u> once each quarter; the deadline for this quarter is 31 March 2025 but <u>we</u> encourage you to do this as soon as possible
